- ***When, before, after***
- **Present continuous: future arrangements**
- **Future time expressions (*next week, in two days’ time...*)**

- **Qualifiers:** *not enough, a little bit, fairly, too, pretty*

“I’VE HAD LOADS OF HOMEWORK RECENTLY”

a) Communication

- Talking about experiences
- Comparing experiences
- Make polite requests with *could*

b) Grammar

- Present perfect (1): *ever* and *never*
- *Been* and *gone, recently*
- Present Perfect v Past Simple
- Agreeing and disagreeing
- *So have I / Neither have I*

UNIT 16: “ANDY HASN’T COME BACK JET”
“SHALL I PUT THE DRINKS IN THE FRIDGE ?”

a) Communication

- Talking about recent events
- Making offers of help and accepting / refusing offers
- Speaking: describe pictures

b) Grammar

- Present Perfect (2): *just, already, yet*
- *I’ll..., and shall’ I/we...?:* offers
- *Will:* spontaneous decisions
- Possessive pronouns

“ WHAT’S A MOUSE FOR ?”

- Talking about conditions
 - Giving information
 - Talking about purpose
 - Computers and computing verbs
- b) **Grammar**
- First conditional (*If I go...*)
 - *When, as soon as, unless*

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- Defining relative clauses: *who, which, that, whose*
- Infinitive for purpose: *it's for + ing, You use it to...*
